Processed fruits and vegetables saw volume sales decline in 2022 as unit prices soared forcing consumers to reduce consumption. Even though domestic production is substantial in this category, local farmers have had to align their prices with growing costs. A shortage of carrots pushed the unit prices of this vegetable up even further, due to poor weather conditions in June when hail badly damaged crops. Overall, consumers are very well educated about the importance of including a variety of veg...
