Some of these may require arthroscopic surgery, as it is helpful in their diagnosis and treatment.

The pain is impairing in nature, and often, a knee replacement procedure is the final and only resort to alleviate pain. Arthroscopic knee surgery for degenerative knee disease is the most common orthopedic procedure in European countries. The demand for knee arthroscopy is increasing in the region, due to the increasing prevalence of sports injuries, particularly those acquired through contact sports.
