Baby formula is expected to register constant and current value growth, but volume growth will be minimal. Georgia's birth rate is falling and this is expected to dampen volume sales, in particular for milk formula and in particular for standard milk formula, as a rising breastfeeding rate also dampens volume sales for standard milk formula. Follow-on and growing-up milk formula are expected to fare better.
