China's resilience was driven by contained COVID-19 and increased consumer activity. Beijing focused on domestic demand, innovation, and livelihoods, implementing effective policies like the Business Environment Version 6.0 reform. Priority was given to advanced industries like IT and healthcare, with initiatives including a scientific innovation fund and a service platform to bridge research and market applications

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- The service sector mainly drives the economic growth of Beijing metropolitan municipality, with a contribution of 82.3% of the total GVA in 2023
- In 2023, the tourism sector experienced a significant rebound following year of pandemic restrictions, especially during holidays, leading to a surge in long-term travel. Beijing recorded 150.0 million tourists in H1 2023, generating CNY2.7 trillion (\$38.5 billion) in revenue, contributing to the economic recovery of the municipality. Outbound tourism also surged, indicating a trend toward diversified consumption. Towards the end of 2023, Malaysia and Singapore introduced 30-day visa-free measures for Chinese citizens, following Thailand's successful five-month visa-free policy, boosting interest in travel across platforms
