Light vehicle sales are showing signs of recovery but are still below pre-pandemic levels. EV registrations soared at a CAGR of 95.2% from 2018 to 2023, however EVs are still relatively small in popularity. The shared mobility sector rebounded post-pandemic, reaching ZAR22.8 billion in gross bookings. The car rentals industry is also recovering, driven by an increase in tourism. Public transportation remains reliant on minibus taxis.
