Summary

Airlines in Australia industry profile provides top-line qualitative and quantitative summary information including: market size (value 2018-23, and forecast to 2028). Key Highlights

- Airlines industry covers passenger air transportation, including scheduled flights but excludes air freight transport. Industry volume is defined as the total seats sold by airlines registered in a particular country or region. Industry value is defined as the total airline revenue generated from passenger traffic. It is calculated by multiplying the average revenue per passenger by the seats sold.
- The Australian airlines industry recorded revenues of \$18.7 billion in 2023, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 0.8% between 2018 and 2023.
- Industry consumption volumes declined with a negative CAGR of 1.4% between 2018 and 2023, to reach a total of 99,439.3 thousand seats in 2023.
- The Australian domestic airline industry is oversaturated. Low-cost airlines such as Jetstar and Tigerair waged fierce price wars, putting pressure on larger carriers like Qantas and Virgin Australia.
