Summary

- Automotive aftermarket includes the sales of automotive components for use on vehicles after first purchase. Market value is calculated in terms of retail selling price (RSP) including all taxes and levies. Market volume refers to each individual aftermarket component, such as wiper blades or brake calipers, considered as a separate unit. The scope includes components sold through fast fits, auto centres, garages, tyre specialists, vehicle manufacturer networks, petrol stations, hypermarkets, crash repair centres/body shops, online sales, parts & accessories stores, and others. Both internal combustion engines and electric vehicles are considered in our scope. Our analysis encompasses both passenger cars and light commercial vehicles.
- The South African automotive aftermarket sector recorded revenues of \$6.3 billion in 2023, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 0.4% between 2018 and 2023.
- Market consumption volume increased with a CAGR of 0.5% between 2018 and 2023, to reach a total of 111.6 million units in 2023.
- South Africa captured a 0.7% share in the global automotive aftermarket sector in 2023.
