Construction in Australia

Summary

Key Highlights

- Construction market includes both residential and non-residential construction. Market value refers to the total output value of construction activity in a specific year. Construction output value is defined as the total value of construction activity in any given period, including costs related to all materials, equipment, and services used.
- The Australian construction industry recorded revenues of \$200.4 billion in 2024, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 6.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- The non-residential segment accounted for the industry's largest proportion in 2024, with total revenues of \$136.2 billion, equivalent to 68.0% of the industry's overall value.
- In 2024, the Australian construction industry recorded an annual growth of 4.2% due to massive investments in infrastructure development networks, such as bridges, flyovers, and airports. For instance, in August 2024, Western Sydney Airport completed over 80% of its new runway, paving the way for the acceleration of internal fit-out. The airport is expected to commence domestic, international, and air cargo services from late 2026.
