- The automotive aftermarket includes the sales of automotive components for use on vehicles after the first purchase. Market value is calculated in terms of retail selling price (RSP), including all taxes and levies. Market volume refers to each aftermarket component, such as wiper blades or brake calipers, considered as a separate unit. The market scope includes components sold through fast fits, autocenters, garages, tire specialists, vehicle manufacturer networks, petrol stations, hypermarkets, crash repair centers/bodyshops, online sales, parts & accessories stores, and others. Both internal combustion engines and electric vehicles are considered in our scope. Our analysis encompasses both passenger cars and light commercial vehicles.
- The South African automotive aftermarket sector recorded revenues of \$6.1 billion in 2024, representing a compound annual growth rate (CAGR) of 2.3% between 2019 and 2024.
- Sector consumption volume increased with a CAGR of 0.2% between 2019 and 2024, reaching a total of 116.4 million units in 2024.
- In 2024, South Africa accounted for a 20.2% revenue share of the Middle East & Africa automotive aftermarket sector, with its expansion primarily driven by national economic growth, rising standard of living, and higher income.
